Instructions

In accordance with Section 3.1.4 of the Port of Townsville Port Notices and Emergency Responses for Port Users (October 1998) a permit is required to undertake vessel cleaning works at the Port of Townsville.

This permit application and approval process ensures the wide application of the zero discharge policy adopted in the Port of Townsville's Environmental Policy.

In light of the potential environmental harm which may result from vessel cleaning activities (ie. the introduction of marine pests through hull cleaning or discharge of pollutants through hold washing) this permit aims to ensure that such activities are well controlled within the Port of Townsville to minimise the potential for environmental harm.

Failure to obtain a permit for such works may result in a fine of 25 Penalty Units being imposed on the responsible organisation. Additionally, failure to comply with any or all conditions of the permit will result in a fine of 25 Penalty Units for each non-compliance incident.
